Situation on November 3 1956.

On November 3 the President of the People's Republic dismissed the members of the government. With the exception of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs and the Ministry of Defense, the National Government appointed Deputy ministers.

János KADAR's announcement on November 4 1956.

"The Hungarian revolutionary worker-peasant government has been formed. On October 23 a mass movement, started in Hungary with the aim of correcting the crimes committed by KISS and his accomplices against the Party and the people and of defending our national independence and sovereignty brought danger upon our socialist achievements, our people's democracy, our worker-peasant rule, the whole existence of

Our fatherland, through the assistance of the Iron RAGI government and counter-revolutionary elements who forced their way into the country. This prompted us, Hungarian patriots, to form the Hungarian revolutionary worker-peasant government."

On November 7 1956 members of the Hungarian revolutionary worker-peasant government were sworn in in the presence of István DOBOSI, President of the Presidium. (Nov. 8.11.56.)

Resolution of the Hungarian revolutionary worker-peasant government of the management of the branches of state administration:

1. Of the members of the Hungarian revolutionary worker-peasant government Deputy Premier Dr. Ferenc SZABOCS was put in charge of armed forces and public order, Imre BODVÁR of foreign affairs, István BODNA of finance, Antal ÁRKAI of industry, Imre DOBOSI of agriculture and Sándor SZALAI of commerce.
2. The Hungarian revolutionary worker-peasant government authorizes its above-mentioned members to appoint provisional departmental heads to the various ministries. (Signed by János KADAR, President of the Hungarian revolutionary worker-peasant government.) (Nov. 9.11.56.)
