B U D A P E S T - Hungarian revolutionary workers and peasants government dissolves revolutionary committees, the Hungarian newspapers of December fifth published the decision of the Hungarian revolutionary workers and peasants government on the dissolving of the revolutionary committees and other similar bodies.

In the period after October twentythird, nineteen fifty six, revolutionary committees and other organs named similarly were set up in the ministries, organs and offices of state competence, and in other offices, institutes and institutions.

The activity of the revolutionary committees was defined by the government decree of November ninth, nineteen fifty six, and the decision of November twelfth, nineteen fifty six. However, in some places the so-called revolutionary committees do not heed these decisions and hinder the activity of the local organs which are competent to undertake measures. Moreover, unknown persons have set up an organ called "the central executive committee of the revolutionary committees".

According to experiences gained hitherto the revolutionary committees are undertaking no important activity for the public, on the contrary, where they still exist, their activity has a harmful influence on the work of the state and economic organs and hampers the solving of questions of public interest.

Beginning with today, therefore, the Hungarian revolutionary workers and peasants government is dissolving the revolutionary committees and their central executive committee and forbids their activity. Leading workers, who were unlawfully removed from their posts by the revolutionary committees, are to immediately return to their places of work.
