Chairman:	Miklós DOMBÓTI	Master-carpenter; Was elected MP in 1947 on the list of the Communist Party; Became Chairman of the National Trade Union of Construction Industry Workers.
Vice-Chairman:	Miklós MÁR-KITTES	Prior to the war First Secretary of the Iron Workers' Union. Member of the old Socialist Party; Was elected MP in 1947; Secretary of State at the Ministry of Building and Public Works; Was arrested in 1953 and probably released in 1955.
First Secretary:	Sándor GÁSPÁR	Car mechanic; Became Secretary of the Iron Workers' Union and member of the Central Committee of the Hungarian Workers' Party in 1953; MP; Became member of the Presidency and Secretary of the Hungarian Trades Union Council in 1953; Became President of the Hungarian Trades Union Council and member of the Presidency of the Hungarian People's Republic in 1955; Since July 1956 alternate member of the Politbureau of the Hungarian Workers' Party; Member of the parliamentary foreign, economic and financial committees.
First Deputy of First Secretary:	Géza KISSZAKI	Prior to the war member of the Executive Committee of the Social Democratic Party and one of the leaders of the Trade Union of Construction Industry Workers; Became President of the Trades Union Council and MP in 1947; Was arrested in 1951 and released in 1955.

Jeno FOZE Member of the Hungarian Workers' Party;
 Became Chairman of the Scientific Association of
 Machine Industry in 1932;
 Between 1933 and 1934 Deputy Minister at the
 Ministry of Metallurgy and Machine Industry;
 Became Secretary of the Hungarian Trades Union
 Council in 1939.
 Became alternate member of the Central Committee
 of the Hungarian Workers' Party in 1956.

Secretaries: Erno LENTAI Toolman;
 Became Chairman of the State Employees' Trade
 Union;
 Since 1955 member of the Presidium and Secretary
 of the Hungarian Trades Union Council;
 Honored Worker of the Republic.

Miklos János HORVAT Member of the National Council of the People's
 Patriotic Front;
 Secretary of the National Peace Council;
 Member of the Presidium of the Hungro-Social
 Society;
 Member of the Central Committee of the Union of
 Working Youth.
